Best for	The classic Victoria Falls experience	Looking for a quieter atmosphere
Views	Approximately 75% of the waterfall is visible, offering the most iconic panoramic views on foot.	Approximately 25% of the falls are visible, with dramatic close-up perspectives on foot.
Best Season	Excellent year-round, particularly during high water (February–May)	Best during medium to low water (February–September), especially for seasonal activities
Walking trails	Extensive network of viewpoints through Victoria Falls National Park	Shorter trails with intimate viewpoints and dramatic gorge access
Water flow experience	Spectacular during all seasons, although heavy spray can obscure views at peak flow	Water levels vary considerably; sections of the falls may dry up during late dry season
Signature experiences	Scenic helicopter flights, sunset cruises, rainforest walks, historic Victoria Falls Bridge	Devil's Pool*, Livingstone Island*, Scenic helicopter flights, rhino tracking,
Atmosphere	Bustling safari town with a wide choice of restaurants, shops, and activities	Relaxed, peaceful, and more secluded with a lodge-focused experience
